Case Study

The Indian Gymkhana Sports Club in Isleworth contacted Zenith regarding canopies to be installed in front of their pavilion to provide an increased covered hospitality area overlooking their hockey and sports pitches. This was to provide extra covered catering facilities during match days but to also provide an extra covered and enclosed facility for weddings, banquets and other hospitality functions. The Sports Club has a very large membership and is a very important part of the local community.

Ian Manners of Zenith met the Club Secretary Sutantar Soni and Richard Keys, their architect. Ian carried out a site survey and recommended $3 \times 8m \times 8m$ Airone Max 175 ($8m \times 24m$) with white powder coated steel work and soft PVC canopies in RAL 9010 White. Ian Manners explained, the extra $192m^2$ covered area would allow them to seat approximately 180 people for the various functions.

After careful consideration, the Club decided to proceed with the project. They decided to add glazed sides with double opening doors which were provided by another contractor. These fitted easily within the framework of the structures.

After the canopies were installed, the Club have added heating, lighting and internal drapes beneath the canopies.

By installing the canopies, the Club achieved what they set out to do by adding another dimension for a variety of restaurant and banqueting functions for weddings, parties and society dinners.

Since the installation, they have provided hospitality for numerous parties and events.

The Airone Max 175 structures are available in sizes from 7m up to 10m or multiple thereof and can be produced in bespoke sizes.
