Case Study

Richard White, the Bursar at Princes Mead School contacted Zenith to quote for canopies for their new reception and nursery classes as they were refurbishing one of their buildings and installing new doorways to access the new play areas.

After carrying out a site survey, Ian Manners of Zenith recommended 1 x $5.8m \times 4.7m$ and 1 x $4m \times 4m$ Cicogna 150 in two separate areas. The school had to get planning permission for the revamp and canopies and by choosing white powder coated steelwork and RAL 7037 Grey canopies, the colours suited the environment and permission was granted.

There was a requirement to choose a structure with a relatively low-pitched canopy covering and the Cicogna 150 not only provided this with the curved roof but also closely followed the shape of the bell and clock tower on top of the building.

lan liaised with Ben Stuckey, the Estates Manager and the canopies were installed during an October half term in conjunction with the new landscaped area, carried out by another contractor.

Richard White and the school were delighted with the canopies and the pupils are now benefitting from covered all year-round play, regardless of the weather.
